Micah's Garden Guidelines

- 1. Plot fees are due in full before the garden season begins (\$30 per plot plus 2 hours per month of service to Micah's Garden for the 2016 growing season). These will be opportunities to tend the collective grounds, the 4 community plots, and to have fun getting to know each other.
- 2. Each gardener must complete a Release of all Claims form before any work in the garden can begin.
- 3. Assignment of garden plots will be awarded by a lottery system. Preference for this year's plots will be given to this last's participants first.
- 4. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are the responsibility of the gardener.
- 5. A limited number of tools, hoses and watering equipment will be available in the community garden storage bin for use.
- 6. Please keep garden gate closed and return all tools.
- 7. Micah's Garden welcomes children with adult supervision.
- 8. Garden plots should be cared for at least once a week. It is the gardener's responsibility to notify the coordinator if he or she is not able to care for their plot in any given week. Please keep your plot neat and clean with no trash, standing water, unsightly objects or freestanding structures. Weeds must be kept under control and plant litter must be removed.
- 9. Community Gardeners agree to employ organic gardening practices at Micah's Garden: mechanical weeding, composting, companion planting, and the like. Organic fertilizers and pesticides are allowed. The application of synthetic herbicides (weed killers) to the garden plots is prohibited.
- 10. Please do not harvest vegetables and flowers from your neighbor's plot. All gardeners are encouraged to help harvest from the 4 community plots for our food pantry partners on Wednesdays.
- 11. Feel free to donate surplus produce from your plot to our food pantry partners on Wednesdays.
- 12. Only legal produce may be planted at Micah's Garden.
- 13. At the end of the growing season, gardeners will clear their plot of all plant material and leaving the plot as they found it in the spring.
